Message from the Vicar of the Cathedral

My dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour!

Nation: The uncertainty that continues to prevail in the country is extremely sad and disheartening. With the prospects of either the Presidential or Provincial Council Elections looming on the horizon, our politicians seem hesitant to take steps to address the challenges that people seem to be faced with as they are safeguarding themselves and their own positions.

I request your prayers for the people of our nation, that they will not be victims of the political schemes of our politicians.

Church: As I share these thoughts with you, our Metropolitan, His Grace the Archbishop of Canterbury, and his wife, have just completed a solidarity visit to Sri Lanka. The visit has been one that has been extremely encouraging to all who have been affected by the tragedy that took place in our country on Easter day.

I wish to place on record my gratitude to all of you who have assisted me facilitate the necessary arrangements in order that a meaningful offering of worship could have been hosted in our Cathedral. Plant Tress, Plant Life: An initiative by our Diocese to plant 20,000 trees, will take place on the 14th September 2019. The initiative is a result of a resolution presented and passed in the Diocesan Council of 2017, affirming our commitment to God, our nation and the environment.

I would like to encourage as many of you from the worshipping Community to get behind this initiative and extend your whole hearted support as this is an opportunity for the Christian Community to make visible expression of their stewardship and commitment to the betterment of our country.

ABBA Father: On Saturday, 21st **September 2019, at 7 p.m.,** the Choir of the Cathedral of Christ the Living Saviour, together with the Concord Choir from Melbourne, Australia, will present ABBA FATHER, also featuring the De Lanerolle Brothers and the Choirs of Wesley College, Colombo, and Trinity College, Kandy. Entry tokens are priced at Rs.1000/- and the proceeds are in aid of the Cathedral Outreach Fund.

Outreach Project: I continue to commend the Cathedral Outreach fund to your support. Through this fund monthly support is made available to the family of a young Clergyman who was killed in a motor accident, a family who lost their sole bread winner, and to victims of the Easter day attack at Zion Church, and by providing bibles for lesser affluent Church congregations in the Diocese.

It is my prayer that we will be able, through this opportunity, to look back at where we were, look ahead and where we would like to move towards, and then allow God to challenge us so that we come to know what our part is in that journey.

"Plant Trees, Plant Life"

This is a project to protect Sri Lanka's environment by planting 20,000 trees, with the participation of Churches, Church of Ceylon Youth Movement, Diocesan schools and people of all ages.

Why "Plant Life"?

We plant trees as an act of obedience to God. "I make you trustees of My estate, so care for My creation" (Genesis 1:28 TVT). This makes it a spiritual experience. Being concerned for our environment is being concerned about what God cares for. When we plant trees, it gives us and our planet a better environment:



Trees and greenery are more important than ever in light of the rising levels of pollution. Trees also help tackle climate change. Over one year a mature tree will take up about 22 kilograms of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere, and in exchange release oxygen.

"Plant Trees, Plant Life" also aims to spread awareness to our countrymen, especially to benefit future generations.

Who can participate?

- Anyone interested in protecting Sri Lanka's environment

(You must be in grade 10 or older unless accompanied by parents as the terrain may be demanding).

How can I participate?

General Information

Planting in teams: Every participant will belong to a church or school team (where you must register to participate) and will plant in pairs. The goal is for each pair to plant a minimum of 20 trees in a square area less than 50x50 meters. Therefore, find a hard-working and fun partner!

Refreshments and care: Breakfast, lunch and water will be provided. Doctors and nurses will be on stand-by. Portable toilets will be available.
