from the
Vicar of the
Cathedral

My dear Friends in Christ, Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour!

Church: The present Global health crisis has caused much havoc and hardship to life. I am grateful to a very small group of about three persons who have stepped in to offer their services and expertise in order that the Worshipping Community can connect together for worship. As a result the opportunity to worship has been brought to our living rooms at home. I continue to encourage families and individuals to make use of these openings to strengthen our relationship with God. The

worship services shared in this manner on Palm Sunday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday and thereafter have also reached people in the United Kingdom, United States of America, Canada, Germany, Australia, Dubai, India, New Zealand and many other parts of the world. A closer look at some of the data that we have been monitoring tells us that over 6000 people have viewed these services. We thank God for helping us to connect in worship with people and we also thank God for the ministry that we have been able to extend to people in distress, offering hope and encouragement in times of adversity and uncertainty.

During this time we have also been able to reach out to the elderly in the Worshipping Community who live on their own, in order to ensure that they had the essentials during the extended curfew, besides supporting the Board of Social Responsibility in their relief efforts across the Diocese.

Going forward we will also need to adjust as a Worshipping Community and be prepared for some changes when groups of people are permitted to gather for worship. These health and safety measures may require the seating arrangements in the Cathedral to be changed as a short term measure.

I am also grateful to you for your encouragement, generous support and response to the appeal I made to the Worshipping Community on 15th April 2020. This has enabled us to ensure that we retain our present staff, at least for the moment. Every effort will be made to sustain our commitments without any drastic changes for now. Your fervent prayers, assistance and continued financial support will also be appreciated.

Nation: As the nation battles the Covid 19 Pandemic, a lot of uncertainty seems to prevail. Sadly, even the handling of the National response has not been

consistently robust and meticulous. While the first respondents among the medical professionals have been exemplary in their work ethics and diligence in duty even though their spirits at times may have been subject to disappointment with decisions taken by those in leadership, these person have continued to be steadfast in their work. The nation acknowledges, and appreciates the sacrifices and risks taken by the medical professionals and other first respondents in order to treat and care for those infected with this deadly virus.

The leaders of the country don't appear to have understood the magnitude of this virus. If they have, then the wisdom behind the need to rush into a General Election, without the country returning to normalcy is questionable.

Our priority as a nation ought to be to ensure that the common adversary, in this Covid 19, is neutralized for good. At present scientific evidence seems to suggest that reaching that state will take more time. No doubt Covid 19 is going to disrupt the rhythm of life with face masks and social distancing becoming the order of the day. We will need to learn to cope with these temporary inconveniences for some time, until the health authorities tell us that they have eradicated the problem.

Retirement of the 15th Bishop of Colombo: On reaching the age of 65, Bishop Dhilo will retire as the 15th Diocesan Bishop on the 23rd of May 2020.

We thank God for the ministry of Bishop Dhilo and we take this opportunity to wish Harshini and Bishop Dhilo a blessed time after retirement.

Your prayers will be appreciated as the Diocese will shortly begin the process of choosing its next Bishop under the direction of the Metropolitan of the Church of Ceylon.

Temporary Suspension - The Alpha Course: The prevailing Health Crisis has forced us to suspend the Alpha course until further notice.

The Church bell was tolled from 8.40 a.m. until 8.45 a.m. and thereafter a lamp was lit, a passage of scripture reflected upon and prayers offered, in addition to the observance of two minutes silence.

Obituaries: I regret to inform you of the passing away of Rev. Canon James Ratnanayagam. Fr. James, as many of us fondly refer to him, passed away peacefully in the presence of his family, on the morning 20th April 2020.

Your prayers will be appreciated for Mrs. Lathika Ratnanayagam, his wife, and children, Prasadini, Jayadeva, Deveshta and the extended family, at this time of bereavement.

I also regret to inform you of the passing away of Swantri Dassenaike in the early hours of 18th April 2020.

AN APPEAL TO THE CATHEDRAL WORHSIPPING COMMUNITY

As the Country continues with a lockdown situation, we at the Cathedral similar to Churches in most parts of the world have not been able to conduct our regular Sunday and other Services. We have however been fortunate to conduct on-line Services that have been compiled by an amazingly dedicated team to whom I am truly grateful and thankful. In fact from the feedback I am receiving, numerous members of the Cathedral community and others have been positively impacted spiritually by the ability to worship from home with our services being delivered to their living rooms.

Apart from these services we have also been extending our support to families (by delivering groceries) in need of supplies, especially the elderly who have no help at hand to procure their regular needs. We have also been in telephone contact with those in our community whom we thought were vulnerable and offered our support if they needed it: and some indeed did and were grateful for our initiative to support them during these difficult times.

I assure you that for our part the Cathedral clergy and our team will continue these on-line services and pastoral care for as long as it takes.

Not being able to conduct regular services and have the Cathedral open as usual means that we have not had any Offertory collections, Thank offerings, Donations and the income we receive through special events such as Thanksgiving Services and Weddings. While this weighs heavily on one side, you will fully appreciate the fact that the work of the Cathedral and its needs have to be sustained and our statutory overheads and commitments have to continue as the situation we are in at the present time has not altered any of these needs.

I also wish to bring to your attention the appeal made by the Bishop of Colombo to assist the Board of Social Responsibility(BSR) to meet the desperate needs of the wider community through contributions towards the distribution of relief packs of food and other essentials. This project is presently in progress in several districts of the country.
