Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour! **Church:** The Church has observed the feast of Pentecost. Thereafter we now move into a period called Ordinary time. During this period of time the focus of the Church will move towards our discipleship as the people of God, growth and the mission of the Church within the community and in the wider community.

In the midst of this the Church continues to grapple with the situation that faces the wider community as result of the Covid 19 Pandemic.

The restrictions on large community gatherings remain.

Social distancing, taking adequate steps to adhere to the required health and safety protocols will have to be considered when permission is finally granted for larger gatherings of people.

Nation: The people of the country will be within their rights to raise legitimate questions on law enforcement in the present context. While there may be adequate guidelines in place to help deal with the current health crisis, the manner in which the guidelines are applied is much to be desired. People in positions of authority appear to have special interpretations and applications to the law and health and safety protocol in place for all.

There also seems to be an undue urgency to declare an end to the health crisis caused by the Covid 19 global health Pandemic. Responsible officials must act with a sense of professionalism and not give into the temptation of popular decisions. The wellbeing of the nation's people and their health should not be compromised to suit any political agenda.

Life in the Cathedral:

Notice to Worshipping Community: As indicated on the 13th May 2020, in our effort to assist and co-operate with the authorities to combat the health crisis caused by the Covid 19 Pandemic, the decision to suspend public worship remains unchanged. The Cathedral however is open from 6am – 12noon and from 2pm – 6pm daily for Private Prayer.

The Parish office is now working Monday through to Friday, except at the weekend and on holidays. In order to ensure the health and safety of all, you are

requested to kindly adhere to the basic health and safety protocols in the event you need to call over at the Cathedral office.

Pastoral Care: The Clergy of the Cathedral remain committed to intervene with the required Pastoral care if and where there is an emergency.

Electoral List 2020/2021: The first posting of the Electoral List for 2020-2021 has been made on 26th May 2020.

The eligibility requirements for inclusion in the Electoral Roll are persons who are baptized and confirmed Anglicans over the age of 18 and whose names do not appear in any other Parish Electoral Roll.

Applications for, or objections against, inclusion, must be brought to the attention of the Vicar, in writing, within fourteen days of the first posting.

Annual General Meeting: Due to the prevailing health crisis caused by the Covid 19 global health Pandemic, we have been compelled to postpone the Cathedral Annual General Meeting until further notice. Arrangements will be made for this meeting to be held no sooner the situation is conducive for public gatherings.

Temporary Suspension - The Alpha Course: The prevailing Health Crisis has forced us to suspend the Alpha course until further notice.

Cathedral Office: I regret to inform you that Ms. Sharon Wijesuriya who has worked with us for sometime, has requested that her contract not be extended. Therefore she will leave us at the end of June. We wish her God's blessings and place on record our gratitude for being part of the team as a member of the Cathedral office. Therefore there is an immediate opening in the Cathedral office. We are initially looking for a volunteer to help out in the interim until the vacancy is filled. If there is anyone interested please speak to me without delay, or if there is anyone who would like to join our Cathedral office staff you are welcome to apply for the post. Please speak to me without delay.
