

My dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour!

Church: On 7th November the Church of Ceylon and the Diocese of Colombo celebrated its 175th anniversary. Three Thanksgiving Services, in Sinhala, Tamil and English, were held. Due to the current situation however, these Services of Thanksgiving were held online on Sunday 8th November 2020. The

theme for worship on this day was **From Generation to Generation We Proclaim** your **Praise**!

It is hoped that if and when there is an improvement in the ground situation, a few events planned in this connection would be held as planned. It is also intended to have a larger gathering in July 2021.

The 7th November is also a day of significance to the Cathedral Worshipping Community as it is the Anniversary of the Consecration of our Cathedral. Therefore, the Worship Service Live Streamed for the Cathedral Worshipping Community kept the Diocese of Colombo, the Church of Ceylon and the Cathedral as their points.

As we keep the 47th anniversary of Consecration of our Cathedral, it is my prayer that God will give us a renewed heart, mind and new eyes for all God calls us as a Cathedral Community to engage in by way of Mission and Ministry.

Episcopal Ordination – 16th Bishop of Colombo: The Episcopal Ordination of the 16th Bishop of Colombo took place on 28th October 2020. Due to the situation created by the health pandemic Covid 19, the service was held with special permission being granted by the State Health authorities for only 200 persons to be physically present at the venue. The service was however Live Streamed and televised. Your prayers are requested for the new Bishop as he begins his term in office in these extremely unusual circumstances caused by the current global health crisis.

Nation: In the backdrop of uncertainty and fear caused by the ongoing global health crisis, the much talked about 20th Amendment to the Constitution was passed. The merits and demerits of this Amendment will however be seen with the passage of time.

Much more pressing issues however, like the grievances of the minorities, the burden of debt, missing persons, the disparity between the rich and poor, the ongoing health crisis, all need urgent and sincere attention by the State.

Life in the Cathedral:

Notice to the Worshipping Community: The situation that is being caused by the ongoing health crisis is one that keeps changing rapidly. As I prepare this note for you, instructions issued by the State Health Authorities do not permit public gatherings for worship. The guidelines permit 25 people to be on site at a place of worship. We will keep in touch with you and keep updating you as we proceed.

Sunday School: As a result of the above mentioned situation the Sunday School is taking place online.

Youth Connect: The Youth forum Youth Connect is meeting regularly and I wish to place on record my appreciation to all the young people who join this forum regularly. I also wish to thank Fr. Earnest for journeying with the young people, for encouraging them and being a constant source of support to them.

Live Stream: The 8.30am Service continues to be live streamed for the benefit of those who chose to remain at home and not expose themselves to a health risk at this time.

Other Services: The services being conducted from Monday to Saturday at 7.30am have also been temporarily suspended as a precautionary measure.

The congregation will be kept informed through What's App, text messages and emails of any changes. Details could also be obtained from the Cathedral office or by speaking to the Cathedral Clergy.

Cathedral Finance and Administration Committee - **CFAC**: The Bishop has informed me that he would like those serving currently on CFAC to complete their term of office.

Support for the Cathedral: I also wish to commend to your generous support the work that takes place, even though Community Worship (the backbone of any Worshipping Community) is not permitted due to the ongoing health crisis.

The bank details of the Cathedral have been shared with you, should you wish to extend support through an online bank transaction.

Pastoral Care: The Clergy of the Cathedral remain committed to intervene with the required Pastoral Care if and where there is an emergency.
