#### **MESSAGE FROM THE VICAR OF THE CATHEDRAL**

My dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour!

**Church:** There is much in store for the month of November as the current liturgical calendar ends on the 27th of November 2021. With Advent Sunday we will enter a new liturgical year with the gospel of St. Luke being the focus throughout most of it.

Breaking away from the common understanding of November, I would like to think of this month as a month of remembrance and hope. In Advent, we commence our prayerful preparation for the celebration of the Feast of the Incarnation or the Feast of the Holy Nativity.

We will also observe the following days this month: on the 1st, All Saints' Day; on the 2nd, All Souls' Day; on the 7th, Saints of our Diocese, the Foundation of the Diocese of Colombo, the birthday of the Cathedral, Saints and Martyrs of our land, and on the 30th, St. Andrew's Day.

**Diocesan Council 2021:** The 136th Annual Diocesan Council Sessions will take place on the 26th and 27th of November 2021. In preparation for the council sessions, a preliminary Archdeaconry Conference was held on the 23rd of October 2021 over Zoom and the customary Area Deanery Pre-Council meeting is scheduled to take place on the 13th of November 2021. The preparatory material for all Councillors has been sent to them and the Green Book will reach them in the next few days.

Your prayers would be appreciated for your Diocesan Council representatives Pranavan Rockwood, Mohan Mendis, Misthi Seneviratne & Anagi Wannakuwatte. I trust that they will prepare for your information and education a report of the Council proceedings and keep you informed of any further details.

**Nation:** With every passing day something sad keeps happening in the life of the nation. If what we are having to endure was bad enough, the recently appointed "One Nation, One Law" Presidential Task Force appears to be dragging the nation into further uncertainty and confusion. The composition of the said Presidential Task Force has exposed a lack of representation. Further the choice of persons to give leadership to such endeavours expose the integrity of the decisions.

### 48<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE CATHEDRAL

It is 48 years since the Cathedral of Christ the Living Saviour was consecrated on 7th November 1973 by Rt. Revd. Cyril Abeynaike, Bishop of Colombo at an impressive service attended by nearly 3000 persons representative of the State, Church and other Churches.

The foundation stone for the Cathedral was laid by Bishop Harold de Soysa, the first Sri Lankan Bishop of Colombo, at a service held at Bullers Road on 28th October 1968. A procession consisting of children, church workers and representatives of various parishes set out from Independence Square and marched to the site prior to the service. The architects selected were Mr. T. W. Wynne-Jones for the structure and Mr. Wilson Peiris for the design. The architecture combines traditional elements of the Kandyan period (17th & 18th century) and modern structural design. Each part of the building incorporates the symbolic aspects of the Christian faith. The walls and columns of the Cathedral have an unfinished appearance to symbolize the unfinished task of the Church.

The building was completed in five years, taking into consideration that it must be an open place – as open as weather conditions and hazards will permit. The openness of the Cathedral symbolizes that we are not to shut ourselves away from the world in this building. However, even as we are within it, we are to be mindful of the problems, challenges and opportunities amidst which we live.
