#### MESSAGE FROM THE VICAR OF THE CATHEDRAL

My dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour!

**Church:** We have entered another solemn season of Lent. I urge you all to make time for yourself in this opening we have in the life of the liturgical calendar of the Church to prayerfully reflect on our calling as the people of God.

**Nation:** Our nation continues to go from one crisis to another with no sustainable long-term solution. This litany of issues seems to have begun with the ethnic conflict that gave birth to the war, another uprising in the south, a brain drain in the late 1960's, a displacement of people in 1983, another brain drain thereafter that continues to take place even today, the energy crisis, the economic crisis, the forex crisis and the list continues to lengthen. Successive regimes that have ruled have failed the people of this nation and after being an independent nation for almost 75 years, this tale of woe continues to be the only constant feature in our nation's history.

If the people of our nation want to correct this pattern, then we need to look inward and pay careful attention to the leaders we elect. We will need to make some intentional decisions to replace the popular politicians with selfless statesmen, women and men with vision, integrity and character.

Therefore I encourage the people of God to intentionally intercede in your prayers for maturity in the thinking of our people and sensible expression in their choices.

#### **EARTH HOUR 2022**

Earth Hour is a symbolic lights-out event to raise awareness on climate change that was started in 2007 by the World Wildlife Fund (WWF). It is held every year on the last Saturday of March and this year's event falls on the 26th of March. Supporters from all over the world participate by switching off all their lights for one hour on this day. It might seem an insignificant action but it's more than that. It's a symbol of unity and hope. It's a demonstration of the power of collective action for our future and the planet's.

As stewards of God's creation, we have a collective responsibility for the protection of the environment. Don't let this condemn or overburden you into thinking that it's now your personal responsibility to go and save the rainforests, shut down the coal plants or save an endangered species. As members of the body of Christ, we each have a different purpose and calling. While some may be called to do the above, the rest of us may have more simpler day-to-day actions that we are called to take; things like using reusable bags for our grocery shopping, recycling our paper waste, setting the air conditioning to a sensible temperature so that it cools in a manner that does not resemble winter, perhaps buying an LED bulb the next time you need one, etc. Like switching off your lights for an hour, these may seem insignificant in their impact, but they are achievable for most of us. Done collectively and consistently, they can have a multiplying effect and a major impact in the grander scheme of things. Whether it's a small action we are asked to do or a bigger one, it's still equally important that we do it.

We should spend some time to ask God what he personally wants us to do to protect his creation, and remember that whatever he asks us to do, he gives us the grace to do it. Whether it's a small action we are asked to do or a bigger one, it's all equally important.
