MESSAGE FROM THE VICAR OF THE CATHEDRAL

My dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour!

Church: Having celebrated the Feast of the Pentecost, we move into Ordinary time in our liturgical calendar. This begins with Trinity Sunday where one of the mysteries of our Faith is affirmed in the triune God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Our focus gradually moves to the Mission that the Church engages in. Our overall liturgical colour will be green.

This month we also observe World Environment Day. As part of our stewardship as the people of God, we reaffirm our commitment to work towards safeguarding and protecting our environment. We also need to explore ways and means through which the Church could transform itself into a Green Church.

Nation: The uncertainty and broken state we appear to be in as a nation continues to be highlighted in both the electronic and print media. Further, the brain drain taking place with the exodus of people in search of contentment and a fulfilling life outside the country is sad to note and a cause for concern.

The scale of the breakdown seems massive and however monumental the task, our leaders need to make every attempt to rectify it. They owe it to the people who have been misled and let down.


BISHOP CYRIL ABEYNAIKE MEMORIAL LECTURE

Be an **Activity Leader** by taking over one of the many interesting tasks and campaigns that we would be engaging our participants in during this journey.


