### MESSAGE FROM THE VICAR OF THE CATHEDRAL

Dear Friends,

We are in the season of Advent. While Advent marks the beginning of the Christian calendar it is also a season of preparation and expectation. It is a season where we prepare ourselves for two events. To celebrate the incarnation of Christ and the second coming of Jesus as judge. Along with our preparation there is also an expectation. Expectation gives us hope.

When we look at the season of Advent we have to remember that Advent is Christmas. Unfortunately Christmas has become a commercial venture and a money spinner and made us believe that Advent is the beginning of Christmas. It is unfortunate that those who believe in Christ and know the truth are comfortable in following the commercial path rather than showing the world what the true meaning of Christmas is.

Consumerism has become an evil that creates many who don't have. Hence, the church – the body of Christ, always looks out for such persons, stands on their side and finds ways and means to help integrate them into their rightful place in society, just as Jesus did.

Advent gives us hope and meaning that such a context will change. However, as we wait with expectation we continue to prepare ourselves for the incarnation and his second coming in a meaningful way, by being involved in the liberative work of God.

During this season we reflect on the patriarchs who gave hope of the coming messiah. Abraham the father of faith and David from whose branch Jesus was born are important. The prophets who foretold the birth of Jesus also give hope to God's people. The world we live in finally, hope and love. To a world which is embroiled in power struggle, revenge, war, suspicion, refugees and displaced, the faith of Abraham, the message of the prophets and the promise to David gives us hope that deliverance will come to this world. That deliverance is through the Messiah.



Come Lord Jesus". May God give us the courage to prepare ourselves for a meaningful Christmas.

# Weekly Services at The Cathedral

Every morning, at 7.30 a.m, a short Holy Communion service is held at the tranquil little Chapel (the Chapel of St. Joseph the Worker) at the right side at the entrance of the Cathedral of Christ the Living Saviour.

If you are marking a special day in your life, a day you would like to remember with prayers and thanksgiving to God, this service provides the perfect opportunity to do so with a special blessing. Be it a birthday or wedding anniversary, a commemoration of the death of a loved one, even a day when you began a new chapter in your life and you want to spend a few moments in quiet reflection, come to this morning service. It is where you can pray and worship in the company of a few and have a special prayer said for you.

The morning service is also ideal for elders who may prefer a shorter worship service than the regular Sunday Eucharist. The quiet confines of the Chapel offer a place for peaceful reflection.

The following morning services are held every day (Monday to Saturday) 7.00 am Morning Prayer 7.30 am Holy Eucharist


